PURPOSE & EXPECTED RESULTS



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- Property Chair, Parker Johnson, seeks a high level of participation to ensure everyone has feedback and input in the decision.
 - Survey provides targeted feedback on building layout, purpose, and sizing from members and friends of the congregation while maintaining respondents' anonymity.
- Property Chair seeks measurable direction to guide future decisions for a new location. Feedback of majority to be used for future decisions on facility location, design, and access.
 - Survey provides measurable results to be used to guide future decisions.

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

- Slide 7 contains a word cloud. The larger the word, the more times it was entered by respondents. Therefore, the larger the word is, the more support it received by respondents.








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PROPERTY TYPE


OUTCOME: Purchasing the next property will satisfy nearly 2/3 of respondents.

PROJECTED LENGTH OF TIME AT NEW LOCATION



KEY ACTIVITIES TO BE HELD IN NEW LOCATION



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

WORSHIP AREA CAPACITY




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CAPACITY OF PERSONS


OUTCOME: A worship area with a capacity between 50-100 will satisfy 75% of respondents.

SPATIAL NEEDS




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NUMBER OF ROOMS


OUTCOME: Having no more than four rooms would satisfy 86% of respondents.




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BEST USES OF SPACE


OUTCOME: The creation of a Youth Classroom, Young Adult Space, and Adult Classroom would satisfy 71% of respondents.

SPATIAL NEEDS




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CAPACITY OF PERSONS PER ROOM


OUTCOME: Having a max. capacity of 15 persons per room would satisfy more than 90% of respondents.




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DEDICATED OFFICE SPACE


OUTCOME: Nearly 2/3 of respondents fully support a dedicated office space.

LEVEL OF SUPPORT FOR SOCIAL AREA




OUTCOME: The creation of a social area would satisfy 83% of respondents.

SOCIAL AREA CAPACITY




OUTCOME: Accommodating 50 or fewer persons would satisfy 80% of the congregation.

TRANSPORTATION & PARKING







OUTCOME: Public Transit, Parking Lot/Dedicated Spaces, Drop-off Access Near Entrance would satisfy 75% of respondents.

LOCATION



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
OUTCOME: A central location would satisfy more than 2/3 of respondents.

LEVEL OF SUPPORT FOR SHARED SPACE



SUMMARY OF INITIAL SURVEY RESULTS



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- Purchase of a new facility, expected to be needed for 10-15+ years.
- Worship area should accommodate 50-100
- Three classrooms/small meeting rooms (with many interested in also including a nursery):
 - Youth Classroom (10-15 persons)
 - Young Adult Space (10-15 persons)
 - Adult Classroom (10-15 persons)
- Dedicated office space
- Lobby/social area important (30-50 persons)

SUMMARY OF INITIAL SURVEY RESULTS



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- Transportation (in order of support):
 - Near Public Transit
 - Parking Lot/Dedicated Spaces
 - Drop-off Near Entrance
- Central location
- Congregation should consider sharing space with compatible groups/activities
